

Membership Points System

To qualify for membership, applicants must earn 6 points from the criteria listed below, with at least 3 points earned in Section 1: Publishing Criteria Points.

Points Section 1: Publishing Criteria Points Full-length book published by a commercial or academic press 6 Full-length self-published book (will be reviewed for professionalism and commercial intent by 6 TWUC Membership Committee) Contract offer from a commercial or academic press for full-length book 4 Prose published (or forthcoming with contract) in an anthology or recognized online or print 4 periodical, minimum 5 published pieces, totaling at least 4000 words * Poems published (or forthcoming with contract) by at least 2 recognized online or print 4 periodicals, minimum 8 poems, totaling at least 8 published pages *** Spoken word pieces published (or forthcoming with contract) by at least 2 recognized online or 4 print periodicals, minimum 5 pieces, totaling at least 5 published pages *** Co-authored full-length book published by a commercial or academic press, for which the 3 applicant contributed at least half of the content **** Co-authored full-length self-published book, for which the applicant contributed at least half of the content (will be reviewed for professionalism and commercial intent by TWUC Membership 3 Committee) *, **** Chapbook published by a traditional publisher 3 Self-published chapbook (will be reviewed for professionalism and commercial intent by TWUC 3 Membership Committee) Section 2: Additional Criteria Points Full-length produced spoken word audio or video recording, minimum 20 minutes (will be 3 reviewed for professionalism by TWUC peer review committee) * Recipient of federal, provincial, territorial, and/or municipal grant(s) for writing totaling \$1500 2 or more Appearing as a featured writer and/or spoken word artist at a public reading and/or school visit (for which the writer was paid), minimum 5 readings or solo performances at significant venues 2 Completion of writer-in-residency program, minimum 21 days (consecutive or non-consecutive) Completion of graduate degree in writing (e.g., creative writing, journalism) 2 Completion of undergraduate degree in writing (e.g., creative writing, journalism) 1 Letter of support from a current member of TWUC ** 1 Completion of writing mentorship program including letter of support from mentor ** 1 Member of national, provincial, or territorial writers' organization 1 Recipient of a juried writing award

^{*} The Membership Committee is made up of 3-5 members of the Union who will review the materials submitted with the application and attest to the professionalism of the work.

^{**} No individual can write more than one letter of support per applicant.

^{***} The Membership Committee maintains an evolving list of recognized periodicals, significant venues, and other criteria as per the requirements above.

^{****} If an applicant has more than one co-authored full-length book for which they contributed at least half of the content, each title is worth three points.
